Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)

- must meet income eligibility requirements (for example, a family of three -- mother and two children -- must have a gross income below \$784 a month and countable assets of less than \$1,000)
- a child may be eligible for TANF if deprived due to the absence, death, or disability of a parent
- all adult recipients have a work requirement, and are required to participate in work activities and training for at least 30 hours weekly

Food Stamps services are available to help households with limited income and resources purchase food; household may be one person, a family, or unrelated individuals living together.

Medicaid

- **Low Income Medicaid (LIM)** is for income eligible families with children age 18 and under; covers both children & parents
- **Right From the Start (RSM)** covers income eligible pregnant women and children 19 and under.
- **Aged, Blind or Disabled (ABD)** covers income and asset eligible individuals aged 65 or older or those totally disabled or blind. must be U.S. citizen or lawfully admitted alien.

- **Adult Medically Needy (AMN)** has no income limit; individuals may qualify if medical bills exceed a certain dollar amount (based on monthly income).

Babies Can't Wait is for infants and toddlers with developmental delays or disabilities and their families.

Child Care Assistance is for:

- families with low income;
- families receiving TANF;
- families transitioning from TANF so the adults can work or attend education & training programs.

Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS) helps families pay for early childhood and school age care and education programs.

PeachCare for Uninsured Kids is a comprehensive health care program for uninsured children living in Georgia; it includes primary, preventive, specialist, dental and vision care.

Child Support Enforcement is for anyone who has a child support and/or medical support order, or wants to establish one.

Womens, Infants, and Children (WIC) Food/Nutrition meets the special nutritional needs of low income pregnant, post-partum and breast-feeding women, infants and children up to age five.

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) provides 47 individual and group services to support and assist older Georgians in staying in their homes and communities. These services promote health, self-sufficiency and independence.
