

Career Centers

Career Centers are located in **Blue Ridge, Cartersville, Cedartown, Dalton, Fort Oglethorpe, LaFayette, and Rome.**

Each Career Center has a resource room available to customers and most have a fully-equipped office set aside for employers.

Anyone seeking employment is eligible for **Job Search** assistance from GDL. Customized assistance is available to:

- veterans
- dislocated workers
- persons with disabilities
- older workers
- welfare recipients
- rehabilitated ex-offenders
- migrant & seasonal farm workers
- discouraged workers & youth

Services include:

- access to the Internet for job search throughout Georgia & the U.S.
- assistance in finding a job and/or locating training opportunities



- career guidance
- information on federal and state employment laws and rules
- job matching
- labor market information
- referral to other agencies for individuals with special needs
- financial management & retaining jobs
- resource areas with access to newspapers, self-help books, videos, telephones, PCs, printers, copiers, fax
- workshops for job searching,

GoodWorks! helps TANF applicants, recipients, and non-custodial parents become employed and move to self-sufficiency.

Georgia Works allows laid-off workers who qualify for Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits to receive on-site workplace training, regular UI benefits, and a special training allowance. This allowance is intended to defray some of the costs associated with training such as childcare, transportation, tools, and work clothes.

Employers in the Georgia Works program provide training for a maximum of 24 hours per week for up to eight weeks. Upon successful completion, trainees receive certification of acquired job skills and will be considered for employment.

The Offender and Parolee State Employment and Training Program (TOPSTEP) assists offenders assimilate back into the workforce.

Trade Act Assistance (TAA) assistance is available to workers who have lost their jobs to foreign trade.

Unemployment Insurance assistance is available to individuals both to determine if they are eligible for Unemployment Insurance (UI) and if they are drawing UI and have questions about their benefits.
