

CAREER ADVANCEMENT ACCOUNTS



The Northwest Georgia Workforce Board has received a special pilot project to develop career advancement accounts for low-income individuals and displaced workers in the Northwest Georgia region.

Career Advancement Accounts (CAAs) are self-managed personal training accounts. Individuals in need of new skills may receive assistance valued up to \$6,000 to pay for expenses related to training which can be either through on-the-job training or through classroom training.

Career Advancement Accounts increase customer choice, reduce paperwork, fast tracks customers into training and increase the customer's decision making role in their careers.

Career Advancement Accounts may be available to individuals who meet low-income guidelines or have been laid off from their job due to company downsizing through no fault of their own. Additional eligibility requirements apply.
