

# CAREER ADVANCEMENT ACCOUNTS

The Northwest Georgia Workforce Board has received a special pilot project to develop career advancement accounts for low-income individuals and displaced workers in the Northwest Georgia region.

Career Advancement Accounts (CAAs) are self-managed personal training accounts. Individuals in need of new skills may receive assistance valued up to \$6,000 to pay for expenses related to an on-the-job training program.

Career Advancement Accounts increase customer choice, reduce paperwork, fast tracks customers into training and increase the customer's decision making role in their careers.

Career Advancement Accounts may be available **through Mercy Senior Care to individuals 45 years and older and who reside in Floyd, Gordon, Chattooga, Walker and Catoosa Counties**, meet low-income guidelines or have been laid off from their job due to company downsizing through no fault of their own. Additional eligibility requirements apply.
