In the absence of Angie Douglass, Chairman, Angie Robinson, Vice-Chairman, called the meeting to order. Ms. Robinson asked that those present introduce themselves.

Ms. Robinson then asked for a motion to approve the September 11, 2013 minutes (attached). Ben Arp made the motion to approve the minutes. Curtis Kingsley seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Anthony Rucker presented a financial report. He stated that, due to a formula area, the following corrections to the report should be noted:

Total Expenses: \$754,004.51
Total Available as of 11/1/2013: \$442,137.49

He also explained to the Council that the Out-of-School Youth money has been expended and that In-School Youth funds are being spent for those activities. Gwen Dellinger noted that, under WIA, up to 100% of funds can be spent for Out-of-School youth.

Lesia Lambert presented a nomination (attached) from Dwight Henderson, WIA Coordinator, Rome City Schools, for Tamedia Covington to serve as a Parent of a Youth Eligible for WIA Services. Curtis Kingsley made the motion to accept this nomination. Anne Rapp seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Karla Conetta informed those present that limited performance reports were available due to the transition from the GWS system to the new Geo Solutions system.

Hilda Smith and Merrill Wilcox provided information regarding the Great Promise Partnership,
