## What is WIOA?

WIOA is a federally funded program that prepares eligible adults and dislocated workers for entry or re-entry into the workforce through retraining and education. The program seeks to increase the employment and retention earnings of participants and as a result increase the quality of the workforce, reduce unemployment and enhance the productivity and competitiveness of the customer.

## Eligibility Requirements

- Be 18 years of age
- A resident of the 15-county Northwest Georgia service area (see map)
- Laid off from an industry in one of these counties. Unemployed or laid-off due to lack of work, company closing or downsizing **OR**
- Individuals who are receiving public assistance or family size and income level falls within the income guidelines
