During the past two years there has been a surge in turnover and new hires in the healthcare field. Some of the positions that have increased in pay/benefits are demand occupations in Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist, Respiratory Therapist, Registered Nurse, Emergency Medical Technician, Licensed Practical Nurse, Home Health Aide, Patient Care Technician and Nursing Aide. WorkSource Northwest Georgia assists in providing education, training, and employment opportunities for eligible individuals in Northwest Georgia. Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) is a federally funded program that prepares eligible youth, adults, and dislocated workers for entry or re-entry into the workforce through retraining and education.

National Emergency Disaster Dislocated Worker – Work Experience Program

The Temporary Work Experience Program is designed to train workers who have lost their jobs as a result of the coronavirus pandemic. Additionally, other individuals who have been laid off due to lack of work, a company/business closure, or have been unemployed for 12 of the last 15 weeks and have been actively pursuing employment are encouraged to apply. This COVID-19 Work Experience Program can provide **paid** work experience in **selected counties in Northwest Georgia**.
