*SPEAKER - WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD POLICY*

All Workforce Development Board (WDB) meetings are open to the public. Bidders for service, subcontractors of existing training programs, those who wish to provide new services, or others submitting proposals or providing information to the WIB are invited to attend.

Additionally, those individuals or entities submitting proposals to the WDB, and who have submitted their proposals and/or Request for Proposal (RFP) in a timely manner as outlined under the WDB guidelines, may be recognized to speak and address the WDB concerning the proposal(s) provided that they contact Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) staff through the Northwest Georgia Regional Commission (NWGRC) no later than three (3) business days prior to any scheduled meeting of the WDB. Those contacting staff in a timely manner will be placed on the meeting agenda and may address the WDB for no more than three (3) minutes. Individuals or entities asked by the WDB to clarify their proposal shall be placed on the agenda as a matter of course. Any and all comments shall be limited to matters pertinent to the proposal at issue or questions posed by members of the WDB.
